CHANGE OF ACTIVE TO PASSIVE

SITA PREPARES DISHES. (1)
THE SUBJECT (SITA) DOES SOMETHING. THE VERB (PREPARES) IS SAID TO BE IN ACTIVE VOICE.

DISHES ARE PREPARED BY SITA. (2)
THE VERB (ARE PREPARED) SHOWS THAT SOMETHING IS DONE TO THE SUBJECT (SITA). THE SUBJECT IS SAID TO BE IN PASSIVE VOICE.

DEFINITION :-
A VERB IS SAID TO BE IN ACTIVE VOICE WHEN ITS SUBJECT ACTS. A VERB IS SAID TO BE IN PASSIVE VOICE WHEN ITS SUBJECT IS ACTED UPON.

RULES TO REMEMBER

1. THE SUBJECT OF THE VERB IN ACTIVE VOICE BECOMES THE SUBJECT IN PASSIVE VOICE.
2. ALWAYS USE THE THIRD FORM OF A VERB IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.
3. IF THE VERB IN ACTIVE VOICE HAS AN OBJECT, USE IT AS THE SUBJECT IN THE PASSIVE VOICE. (SITA PREPARES DISHES. DISHES ARE PREPARED BY SITA.)
4. IF THE VERB IN ACTIVE VOICE IS FOLLOWED BY A PREPOSITION, THE SAME IS USED BEFORE 'BY' IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.
5. IF THE VERB HAS TWO OBJECTS, ONE OF THEM IS USED AS THE SUBJECT AND THE OTHER IS USED AS OBJECT IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.

SOME FUNDAMENTAL RULES FOR DIRECT SPEECH

1. WE REPORTED OTHER'S SPEECH.
2. A CONJUNCTION IS GENERALLY USED AFTER THE REPORTING VERB.
3. THE VERB OF THE REPORTING VERB IS CHANGED AS INDICATED BY THE REPORTING VERB.
4. A PERSONAL PRONOUN, ADJECTIVE, VERB, NOUN, OR NUMBER OF THE DIRECT SPEECH IS CHANGED AS INDICATED BY THE REPORTING VERB.

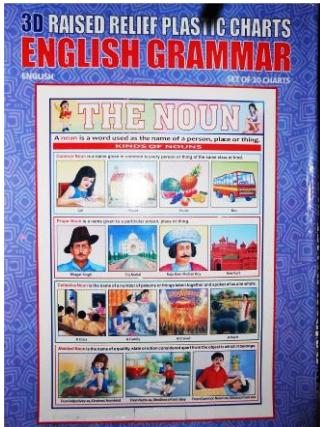
